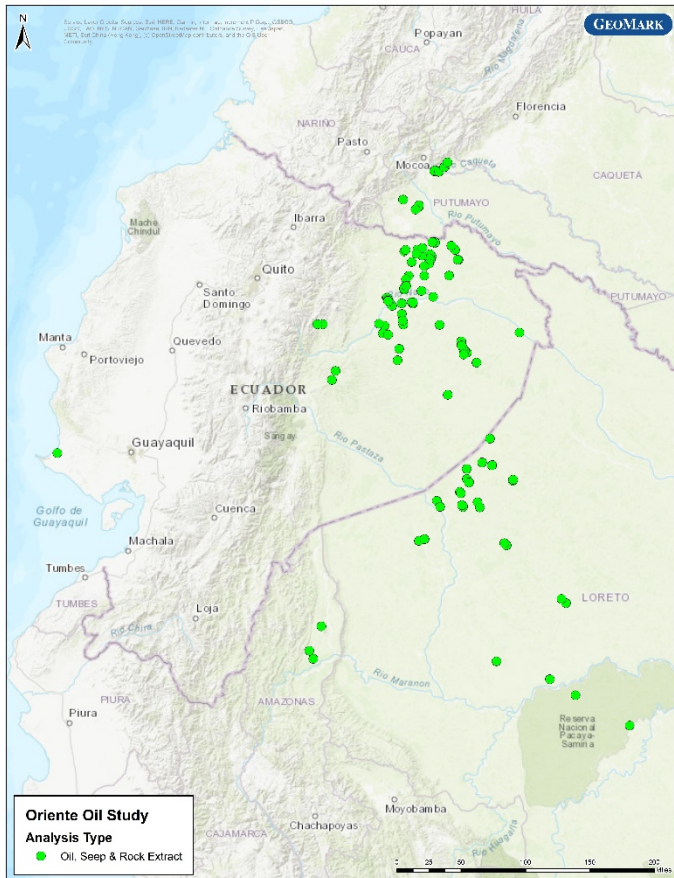


Oriente Oil Study

Regional Petroleum Geochemistry of Crude Oils
From the Oriente, Putumayo, and Marañon Basins



GeoMark Research has completed an extensive analysis of the petroleum systems of the Putumayo, Napo, Marañon and Santiago Basins. The study involved the detailed analysis of 184 crude oil samples collected from all productive stratigraphic horizons.

The results identified both geographically and stratigraphically separated oil families, and conclusively explains much about the source and migration history of the basins. The study serves as an excellent tool for assessing the amount and type of hydrocarbon that can be expected from unexplored regions, and will be of particular value for companies exploring in the foot-hill region.

This study provides valuable insight into:

- The number of petroleum systems active within the regions,
- The character of these systems,
- The relative importance of the differing systems and
- The overall potential of the various regions.
